

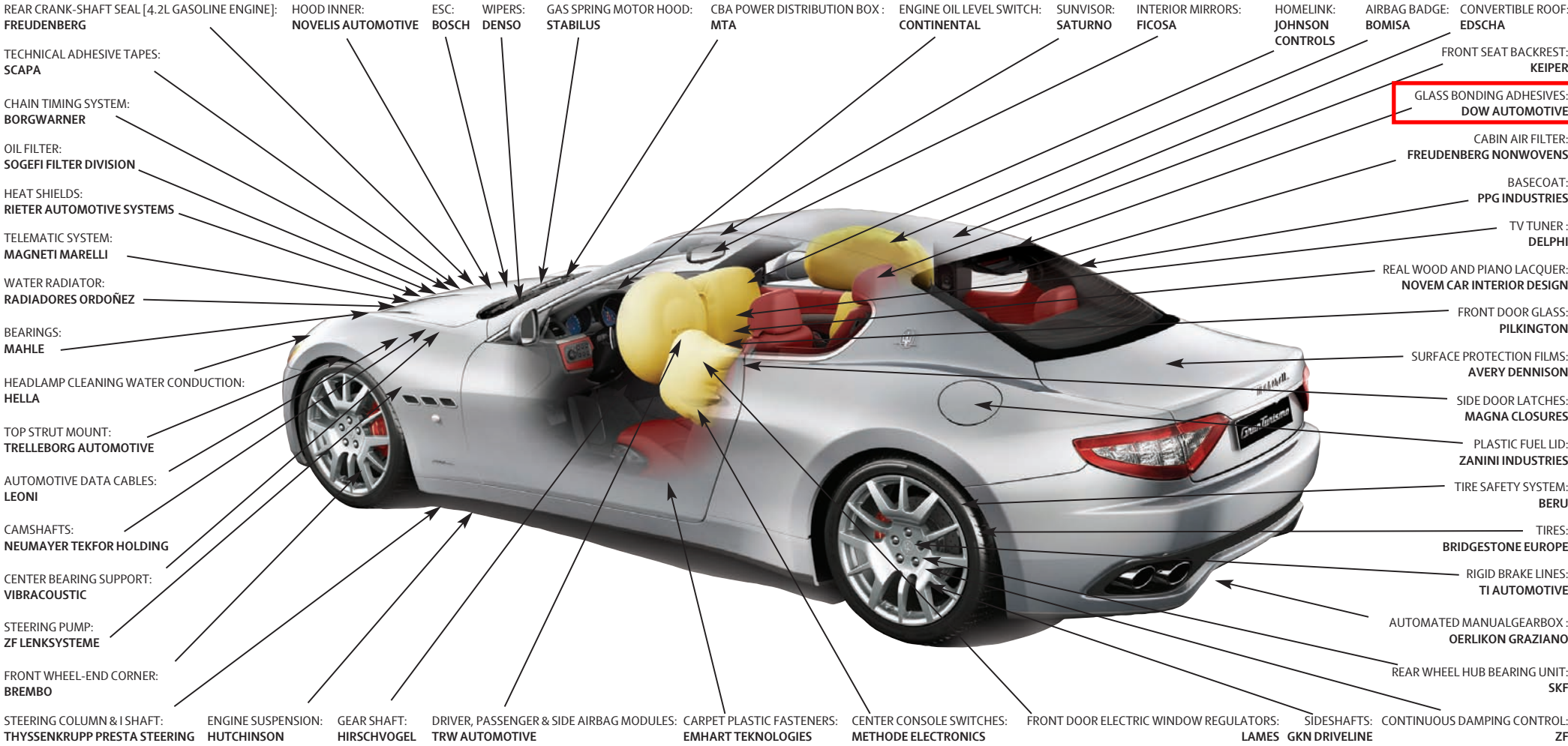
Magneti Marelli help Maserati Gran Turismo see around corners

The Maserati Gran Turismo has many luxury features expected on a high-end vehicle. Magneti Marelli provides the car's infotainment and telematics system, which includes the CD player, satellite navigation, car radio, voice controls and text-to-speech functionality for reading

text messages from a mobile phone. The Italian supplier also provides the GT's xenon lights, which rotate to improve illumination around corners. Benecke-Kaliko, part of ContiTech, provides the vehicle's polyurethane-coated upholstery material for the door trim, seats,

instrument panel and rear tray. The coating improves the upholstery's resistance against damage from sunlight, heat and moisture.
